## 2014 SAUVIGNON BLANC

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Our 2014 Sauvignon Blanc is a multifaceted wine that combines the best elements of our four estate vineyards. It has a light straw yellow color and an enticing nose of kaffir lime, pear, elderberry, crystalized ginger and wet slate. The full palate is highlighted by a sweet attack which is deftly balanced by fresh, vibrant acidity and a purity of fruit. This layered, complex, well-knit wine has an extremely long finish with echoes of citrus, stone fruit and minerality.

### NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

The 2014 growing season was remarkable for its exceptional dryness after budbreak, but in fact the warm dormant winter seasons set the tone for this vintage. Due to the moderate winter, the start of growth was extremely early and this shifted the entire growing season into the warmer and longer days of mid-summer. Fortunately, there were few major heat events. Summer was mild so ripening was slow and complete and fruit quality was exceptional. All told, 2014 was a ideal vintage that made both growers and winemakers happy: sharing the pleasure of harvesting fruit that developed full aromatic maturity while maintaining high acid profiles.
