2013 SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Our 2013 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir strikes a balance between three elements - umami, fresh berry fruit and sous bois - and captures the ruggedness of the growing region. It has a red-rose color with subtle blue highlights and a nose of boysenberry, cranberry and cedar. The significant percent of whole clusters during fermentation lends this wine a savory mouthfeel. The palate is complemented by candied ginger, acute acidity and Thai spice with a long cranberry-laden finish.

NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

The 2013 growing season will be remembered as extremely dry and for producing a bountiful crop of exceptional quality wine. There was an early start to the growing season as the beautiful spring conditions induced budbreak in March. Clear and sunny weather prevailed, which pushed canopy and fruit development along evenly. June and July were mild, which reduced the risk of water stress in this unusually arid season. Above average temperatures in August and September brought on berry maturation, and due to unique soil and topography each of the vineyards expressed the typicality of their cooler sub-regions along the Sonoma Coast.
